JCC Financial Update

Greetings, church family! With the first quarter of 2025 firmly planted in the rearview mirror ... now is a good time to pause, look back, and review the financial health of our church through the first three months.

You may recall that during the Financial Health Presentation in early February, the 2025 budget was ready to be finalized in the next few days. The budget was finalized and approved in the amount of \$229,656.33 ... which requires average weekly undesignated giving of \$4,416.47. So ... let's look at how we've been doing.


YTD March Budget (13 weeks) \$57,414.08 YTD March Undesignated Giving \$52,567.45 YTD March Budget Shortfall (\$4,846.63)

For the first quarter of the year, we have been experiencing an average weekly shortfall of \$373, or roughly 8% short of what we need each week to fully fund our budget. Setting aside the budget for just a moment ... because we know that actual expenses rarely track perfectly with budgeted expenses ... Let's look at how we've been doing in relation to our actual expenses through March.

YTD March Expenses (13 weeks) \$56,781.17 YTD March Undesignated Giving \$52,567.45 YTD March Expense Shortfall (\$4,213.72)

Our first quarter expenses are slightly less than the budgeted expenses, however, we remained \$324 short each week to cover our actual YTD expenses.

The year is still young, and we have time to get back on track and change from:



We will keep you updated over the next several months on our progress toward closing the gap, and we continually trust in our church family's faithfulness in providing what is needed.
